Chairperson Topper, council members, thank you for the opportunity to speak today.

My name is Jamie Gilligan, and I am a junior nursing student at the University of Pittsburgh. I want to share how the state-funded in-state tuition discount has made it possible for me to pursue my education and how it will allow me to give back to Pennsylvania as a future healthcare professional.

Like many students, affordability was among the biggest factors in my decision to attend college. Pitt's in-state tuition discount has allowed me to stay in Pennsylvania, close to my family and community, while receiving a world-class education without an overwhelming financial burden. Without this opportunity, affording tuition would have been much more challenging and I would have attended school out of state due to competitive scholarship offers.
